Significant Arrests

- ? **Officers *Burroughs and Musslewhite* of the Precinct Focus Mission Team were able to check two different individuals and question them after they were observed acting suspiciously in the 800 block of Lancaster Street on two separate dates. They recovered crack cocaine from them. They were arrested.**

- ? **Officers *Salgado, Thomas and Jackson* of the Midnight Shift responded to the area of a robbery in the 2700 block of Chamberlayne Avenue. Good suspect and vehicle descriptions led to the vehicle being spotted nearby, a short time later by the officers. After a short pursuit, the suspects were apprehended. Drugs and a loaded shotgun were recovered.**

- ? **An alert neighbor called to report a subject acting suspiciously in the area of a vacant apartment on Thomas Street. Officer *Donnie Watkins* of Midnight Shift was able to spot the subjects vehicle and make a traffic stop. In the back of the subjects vehicle was a central air conditioning “HVAC” unit. The initial stop and arrest led to the implication of a second suspect who was subsequently located and arrested. Many thanks to the alert citizen!!**

- ? **Officer *Margaret Cunningham* of Day Shift was checking the vacant, former F.F.V. factory with other officers when an insecure door was discovered and loud banging noises were heard coming from within. A check of the building led to the discovery and arrest of two subjects who were stealing copper pipes and tubing inside. GOOD WORK!!**

- ? **Our officers conducted 193 field interviews with suspicious individuals during the month of April 2008. They made 163 arrests, issued 168 traffic summons and handled 2346 calls for service in Sector 412.**

Crime stopper Tips

Yet another alert neighbor “steps up to the plate” during the month of April and two more burglary suspects are taken off the streets. The citizen/ police partnership remains one of the cornerstones of our success in reducing crime.

At the end of April 2008, motor vehicle thefts were down 26% for the year. Robberies were down 32%. Residential burglaries were unfortunately up from 20 in 2007 to 42 in 2008 for an increase of 110%. Burglaries to sheds and outbuildings were up from 3 to 6 for the period. Thefts from motor vehicles were up 74%. PLEASE secure your valuables and don't leave change, toll money, laptop computers, iPods, cell phones, digital cameras, pocketbooks or other items (just to name a few) unsecured in your vehicle. The best weapon you have against crime is right on top of your shoulders. Call to report suspicious persons in your neighborhood. Be a part of the solution.
