### **Significant Arrests**

- **On June 12, the 7-11 Store at 2808 Chamberlayne Avenue was robbed by an individual who fled the scene on a moped. A description of the suspect was quickly obtained and broadcast by responding officers. Officers *Marc Troy* of the Midnight Shift was able to spot a suspect matching the description in the Carver area. With the assistance of the V.C.U. Police, he was able to stop the suspect, who was arrested for robbery.**
- **Officer *Salgado* of the Midnight Shift responded to the area of a reported wanted subject in the 300 block of West Brookland Park Boulevard. A good suspect description given by an alert citizen led to an individual being spotted nearby a short time later. The individual was stopped and arrested. A subsequent search led to the discovery of crack cocaine.**
- **An alert citizen called to report a subject acting suspiciously in the yard of his neighbor in the 1600 block of Wentbridge Road and called the police. Officer *Matthew Stella* of Evening Shift and K-9 Officer *Walter Stone* responded to investigate. Thanks to the neighbor's vigilance, the subject was arrested for burglary.**
- **Officer *Donnie Watkins* of Evening Shift was responding to an alarm at a lawn care business when he observed an individual with some maintenance equipment leaving the area. He was able to stop and detain the subject. After checking the property and the equipment, the subject was arrested for burglary.**

- **Our officers conducted 224 field interviews with suspicious individuals during the month of June 2008. They made 130 arrests, issued 412 traffic summons and handled 2076 calls for service in Sector 412.**
- **There's an old expression that says, "When life gives you lemons, make lemonade." On June 26<sup>th</sup>, Sector 412 officers and citizen volunteers did exactly that, when we set up a "lemonade stand" at the corner of Griffin and Brookland Park Boulevard. On one of the hottest days of the month, we gave out over 120 cold drinks, 17 club devices, crime prevention information and kid's treats. Special thanks to *Mr. Robert Andes and Mr. Larry Jones* who assisted during the operation.**

### **Crime stopper Tips**

**Neighbor after alert neighbor “steps up to the plate” during the month of June and more burglary, robbery and wanted suspects are taken off the streets. The citizen/ police partnership is fundamental to our success in reducing crime. Keep up the good work!!!!**

**At the end of June 2008, in Sector 412, motor vehicle thefts were down 33% for the year. Robberies of business were down 47%. Robberies of individuals were down 23%. Residential burglaries were unfortunately up from 36 in 2007 to 61 in 2008 for an increase of 69%. Thefts from motor vehicles were up 43%. I continue to read police reports of folks who leave IPODS, GPS systems, wallets and other valuable items in plain sight inside their cars. PLEASE secure your valuables and don't leave nice or valuable things unsecured in your vehicle. The best weapon you have against crime is right on top of your shoulders. Keep calling to report suspicious persons in your neighborhood. It's working!!**
